Math: SRA Real Math

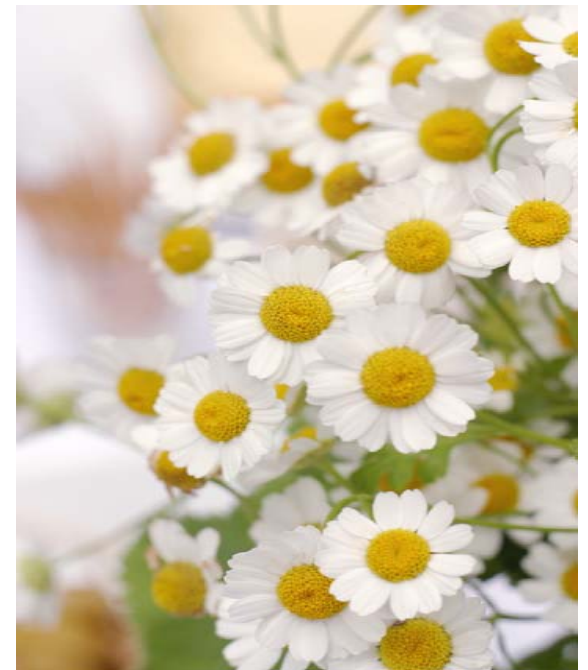
Reading : Individualized Reading Program
