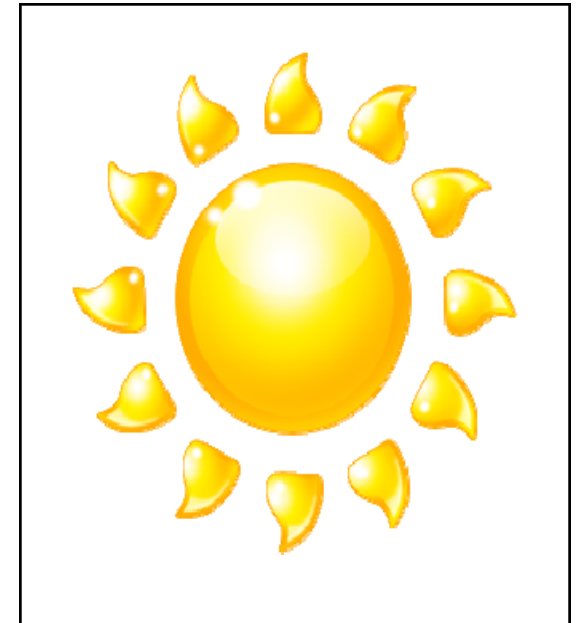
### Leaders/Staff
