MISS DORSETT'S CLASS IS LEARNING SO MUCH










3RD GRADE SCIENCE FUN








7TH GRADE SCIENCE



7TH GRADE COMPUTER


Over the next few weeks, 7th Grade students will work on designing practical items to 3D print on the school's 3D printers. Their designs are off to a great start


