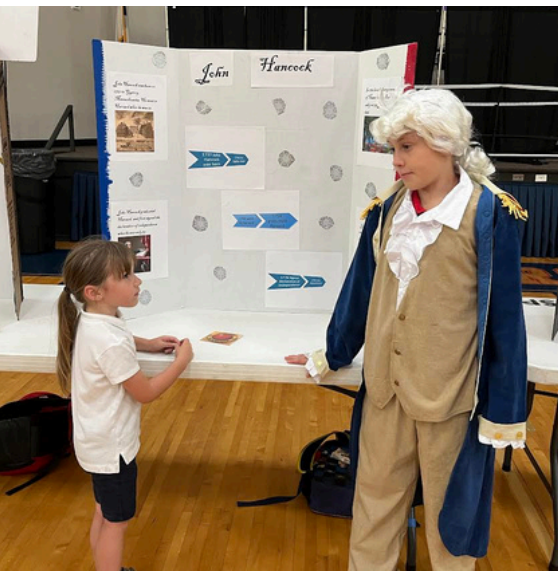
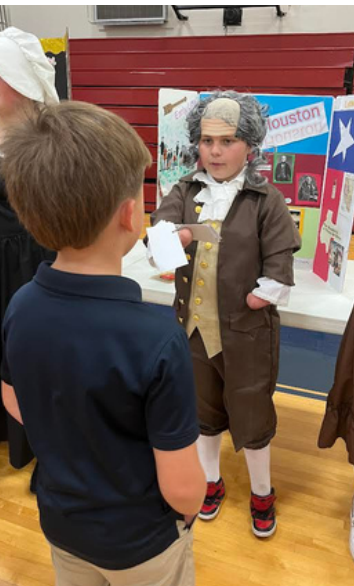

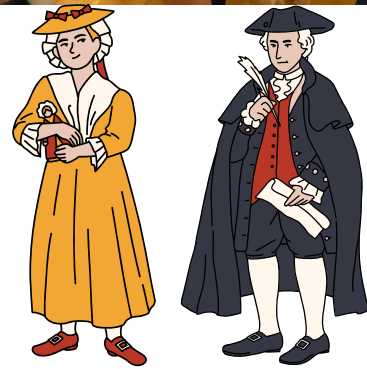
Our 5th Grade students did an awesome job with this year's Statuary Hall. The students, dressed in full character, and provided wonderful information to their younger peers and other guests.

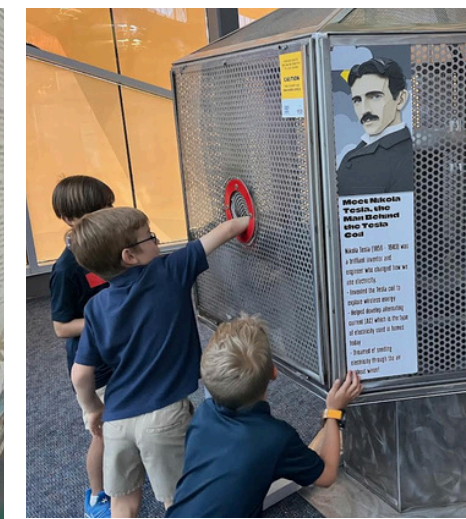
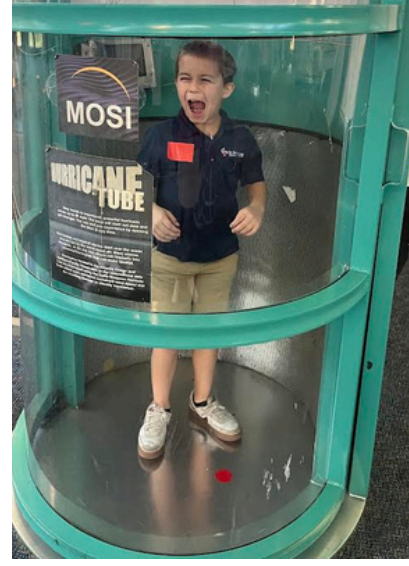
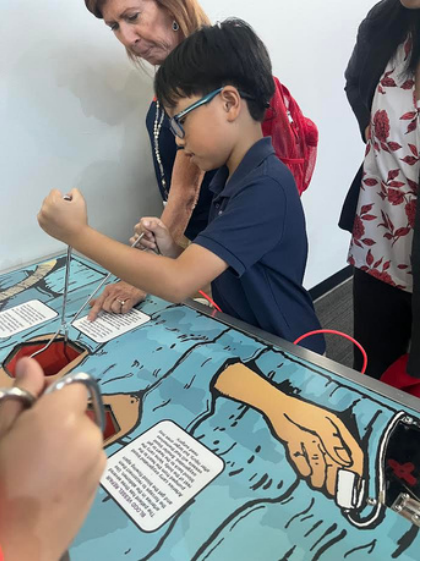




2ND GRADE FIELD TRIP

The 4th graders visited some of the most important and exciting historical sites and museums while on their field trip to St. Augustine last week.

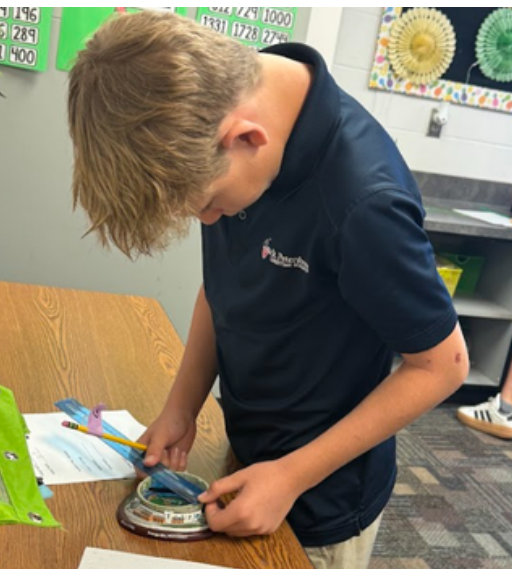
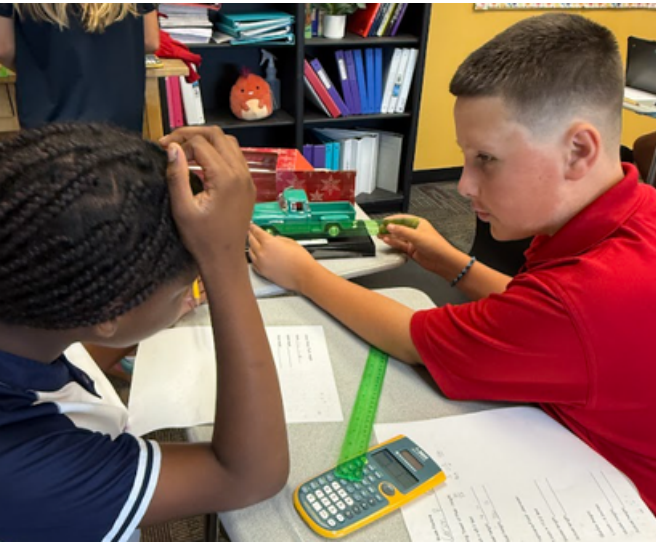

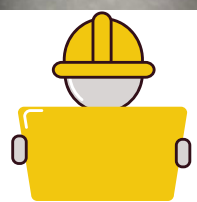
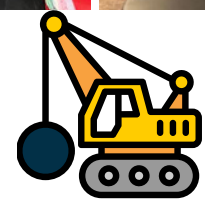
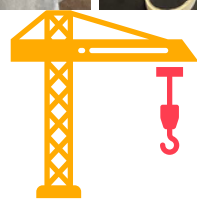
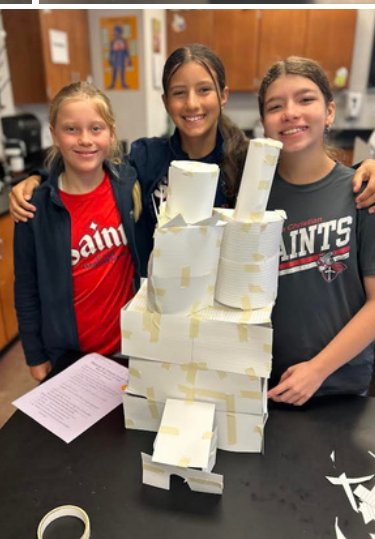
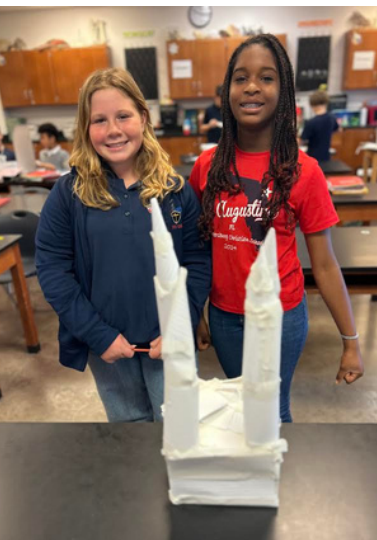
MIDDLE SCHOOL MATH

6TH GRADE SCIENCE

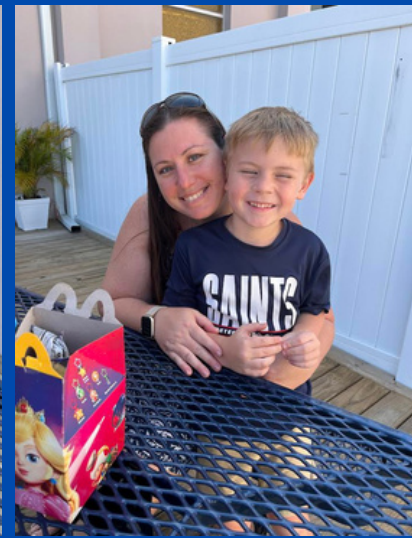
