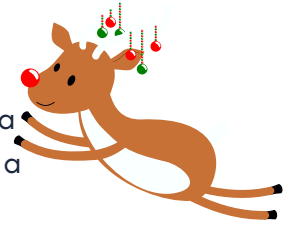

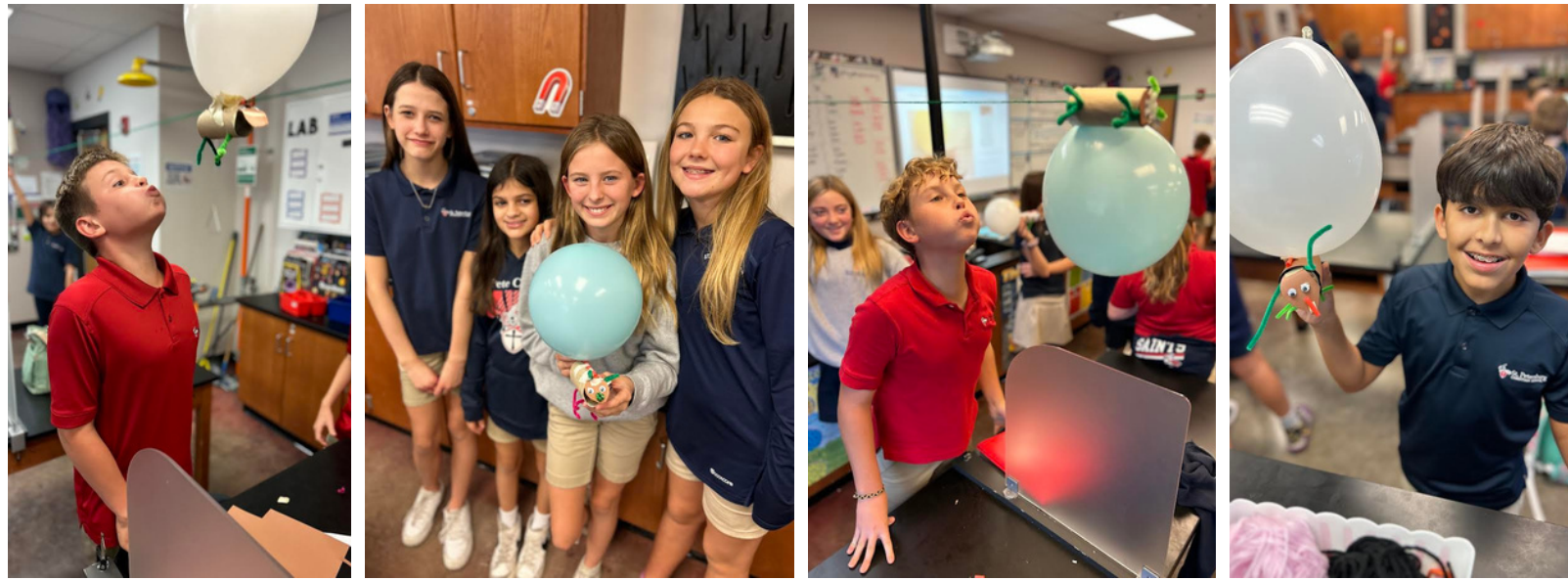

6TH GRADE SCIENCE



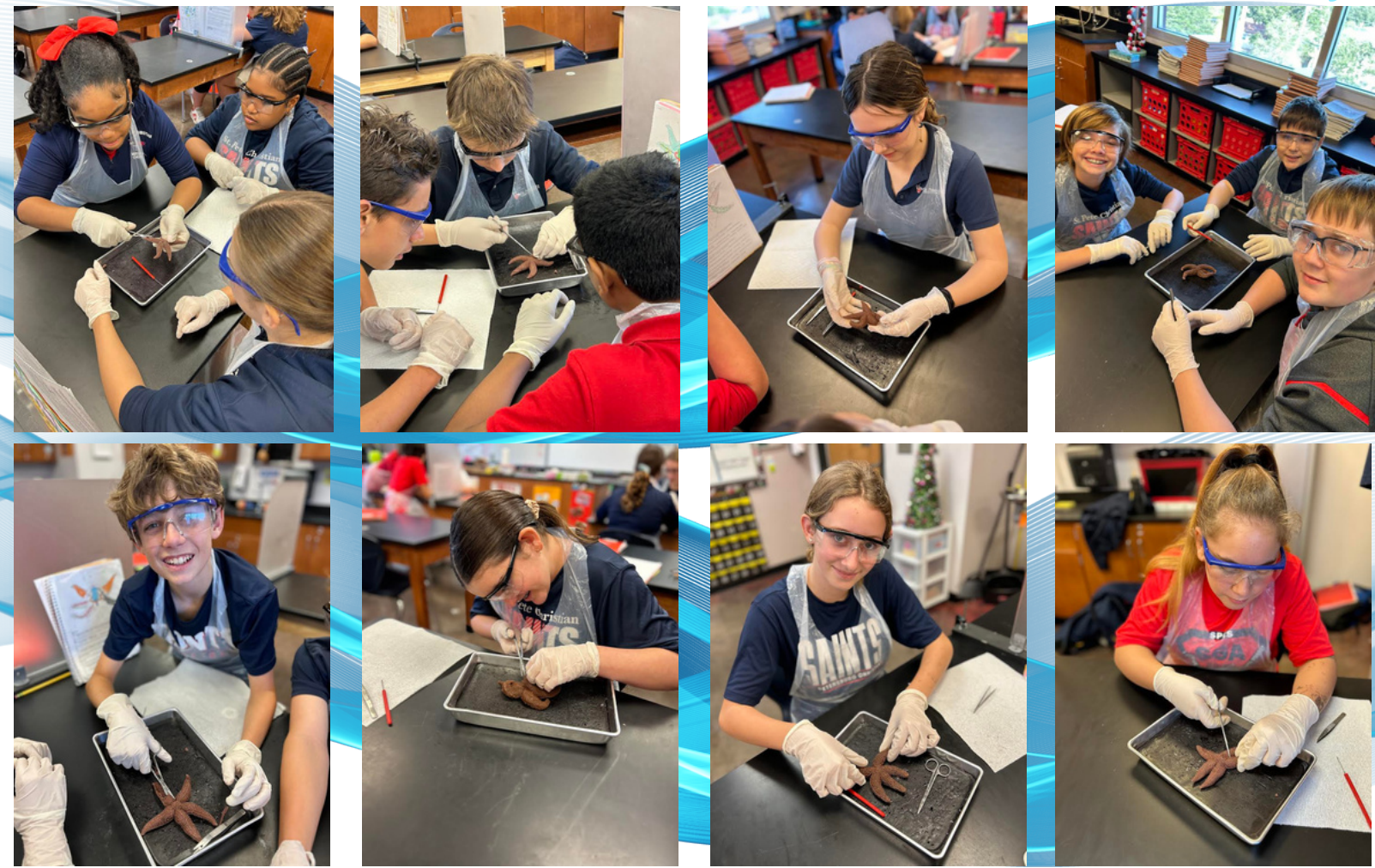

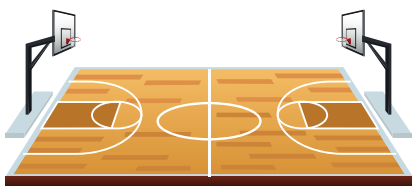
