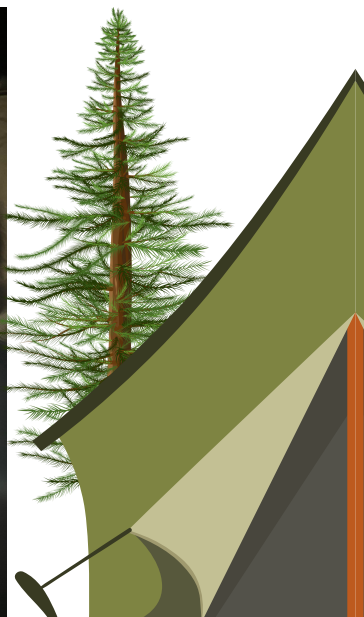
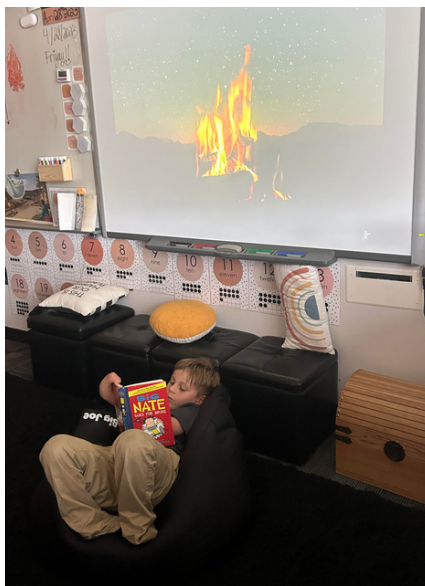
It was a full house for this year's Painting with SPCS event. The colorful and cheerful paintings that were created will brighten many SPCS homes!
