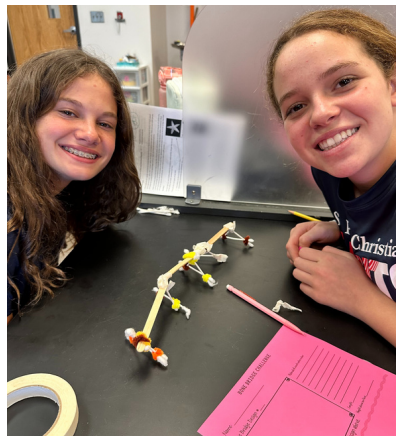
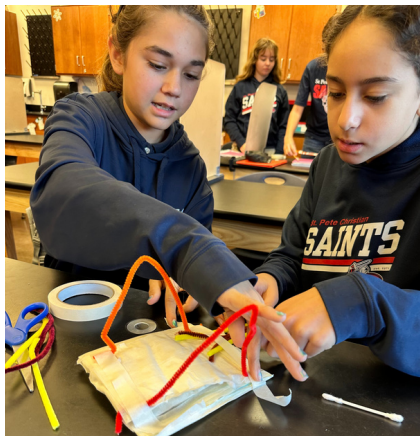
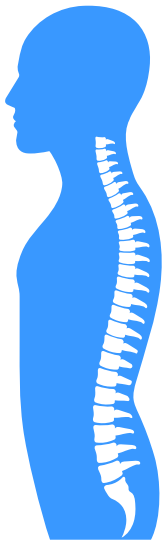
6TH GRADE SCIENCE LAB

Students are exposed to several branches of science in 6th Grade. In a recent chemistry activity, students worked in small groups to create apple canoes. While tying this into their unit on volcanoes, they also learned about acids and bases in a chemistry classroom.



7TH GRADE SCIENCE STEM

Continuing their focus on biological sciences, 7th grade students are learning about various body systems including the musculoskeletal system. Working with partners, they were tasked with a STEM challenge to create a bone bridge following specific criteria and constraints.



8TH GRADE CULINARY CHEMISTRY

This week, partners worked through the steps of the scientific method to predict outcomes of candy in different solvents with "culinary chemistry". They then explained how those reactions occurred based on the type of liquid the candy was placed in.

Fourth grade students enjoyed their "Birds at Brooker" experience which included an owl pellet dissection lab, a bird adaptation interactive presentation, and a boardwalk swamp stroll focusing on bird adaptations, predator/prey interactions, and migratory corridors.
