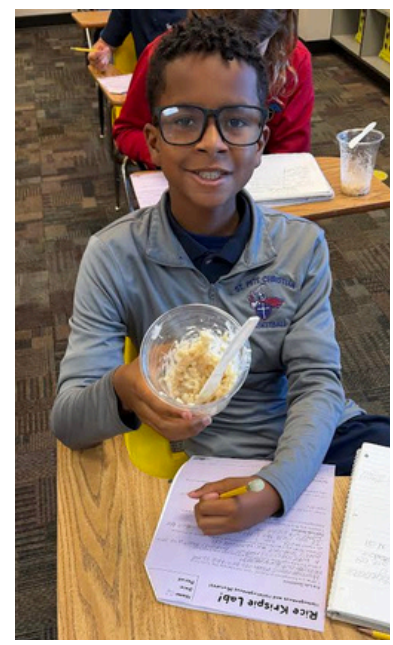
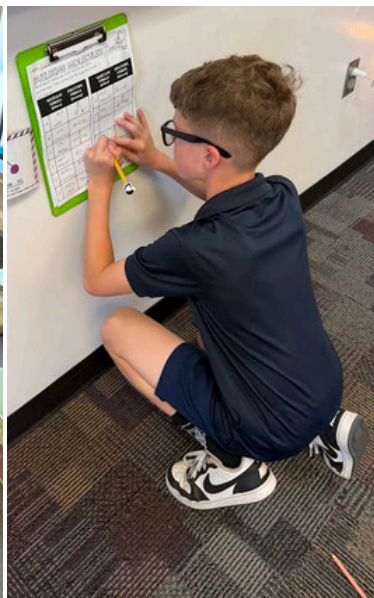

6TH GRADE GUEST SPEAKER

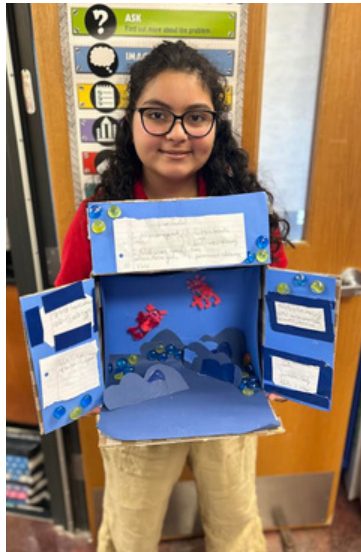

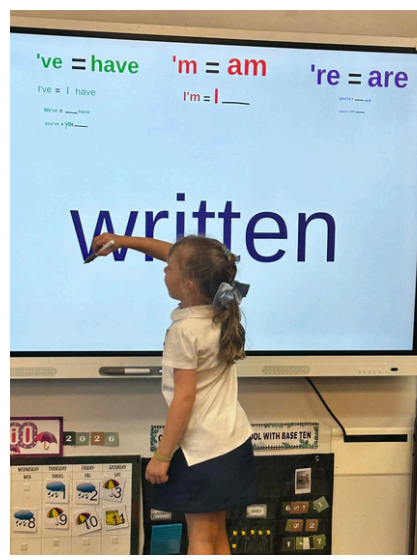
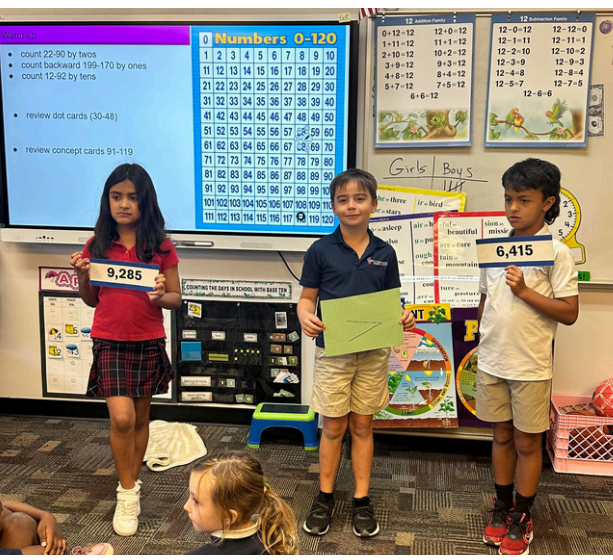
2ND GRADE EARTH DAY

6TH GRADE DAY OF SERVICE

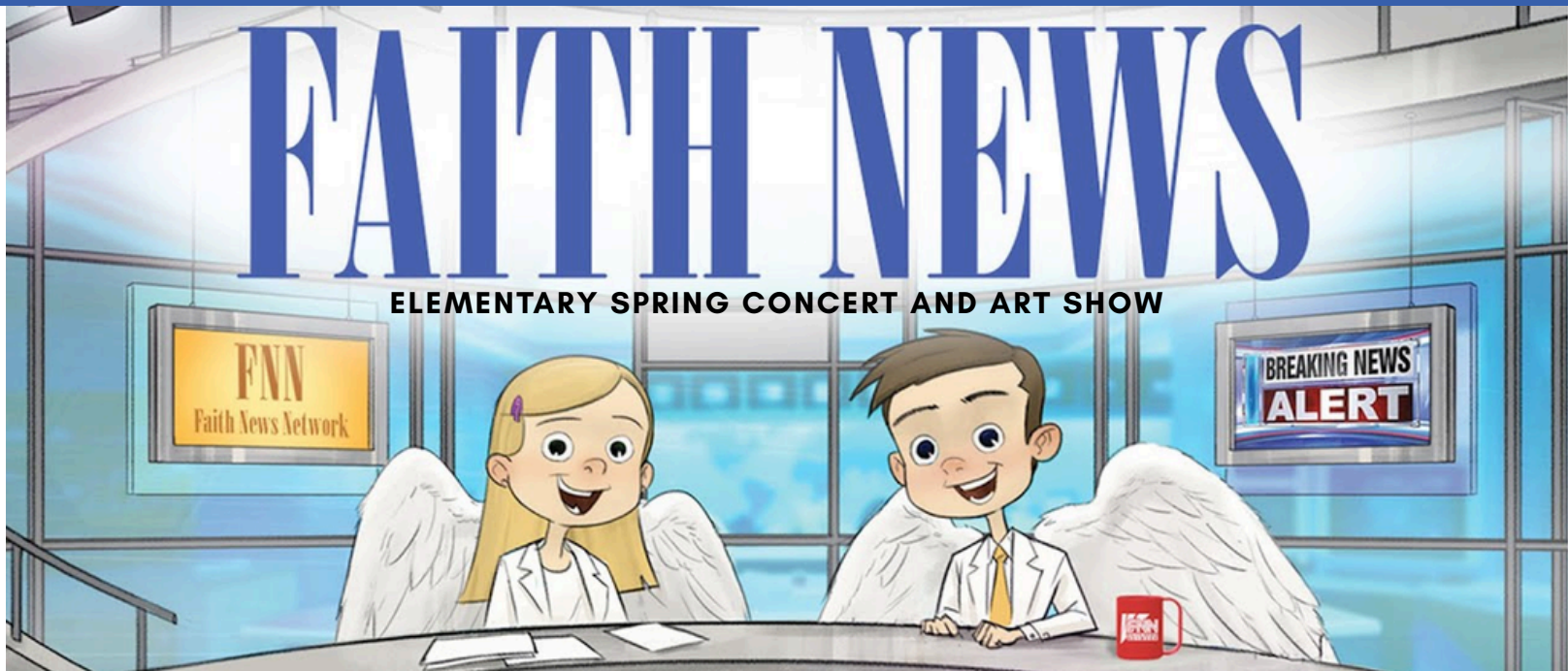

The flag football team continues to play well. Their last 2 games are next week. The Monday game is at 4 and is played on the soccer field across the street at Suncoast.



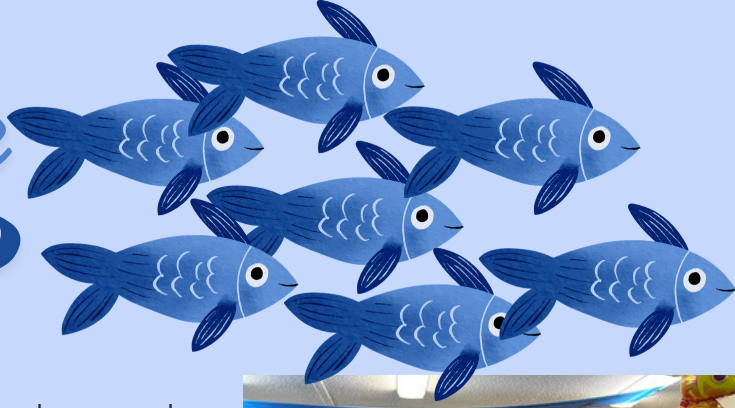
SOFTBALL

The softball team had a great season, winning ALL but one of their games. At their last game, they celebrated Abby, their only 8th Grade player, who was a great teammate and friend!

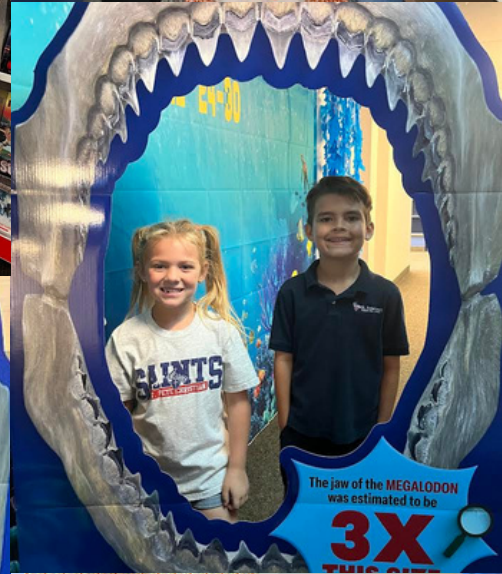
