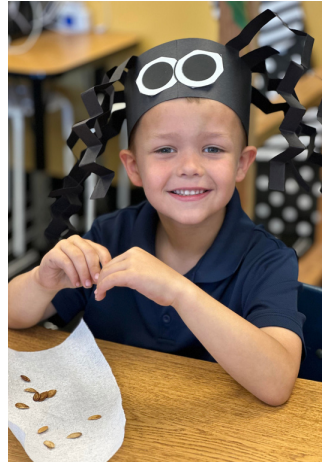

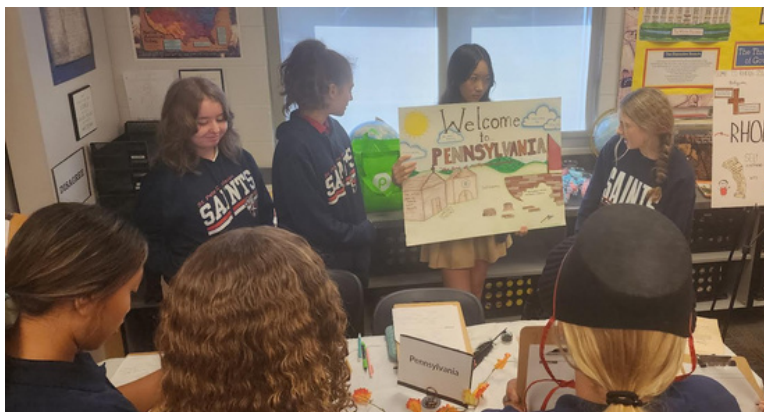
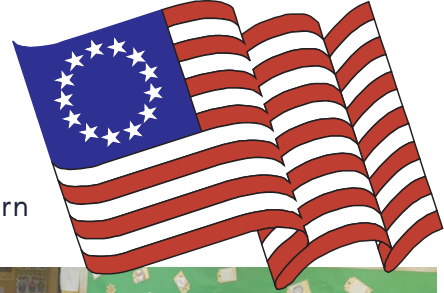
3RD GRADE ENRICHMENT MATH

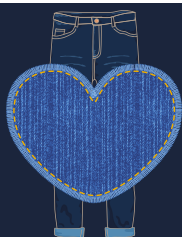
