






# **6TH GRADE SCIENCE**

# 8TH GRADE SCIENCE





















# TH GRADE SCIENCE

To wrap up the year, seventh graders built 3D DNA molecule models. Students worked to create a model of a DNA strand showing the double helix shape and correct bonds.


















# WELCOME 25/26 SGA OFFICERS
