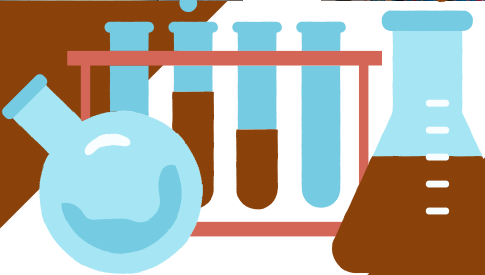
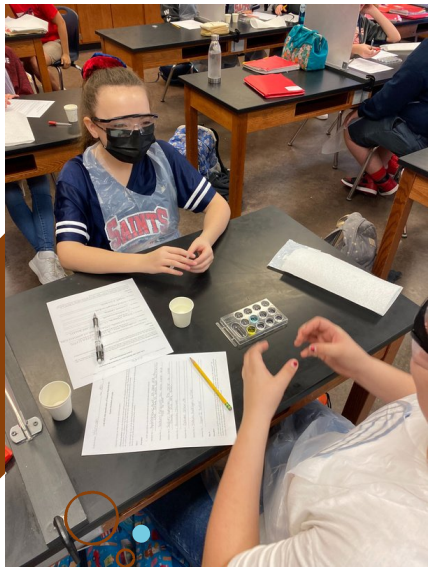
6TH GRADE WINTER SYMMETRY

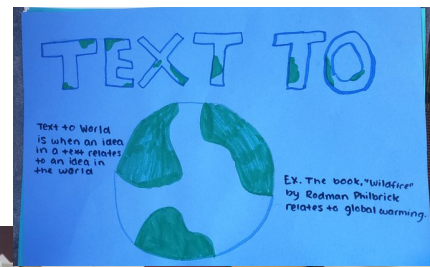
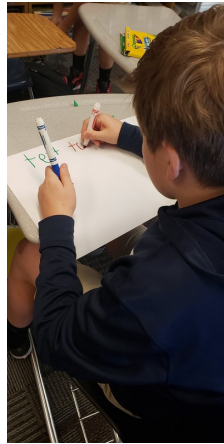
8TH GRADE CHEMISTRY LAB

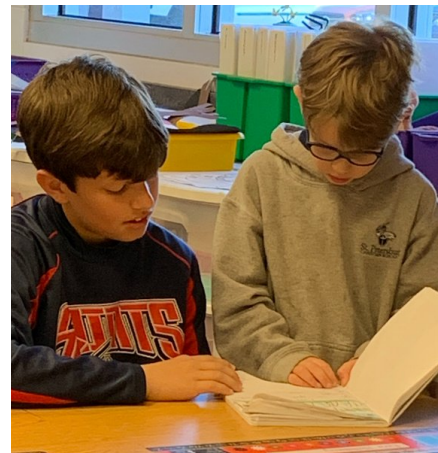
MRS. RENNINGER'S CLASS

Mrs. Renninger's class learned about Lunar New Year. They compared and contrasted how different areas celebrate the New Year.



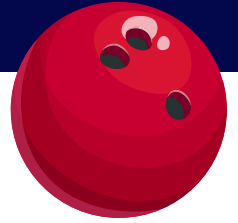
KINDERGARTEN AND 8TH GRADE SHARE TIME

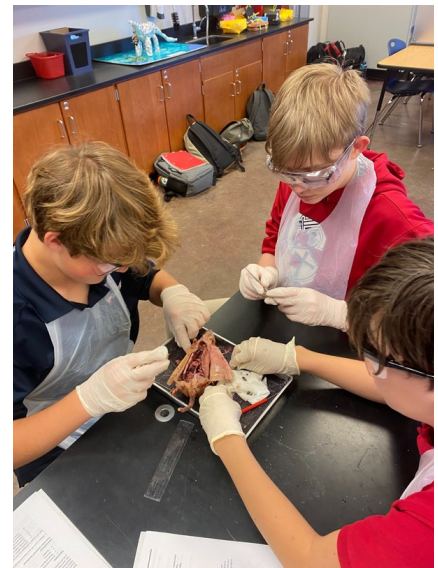

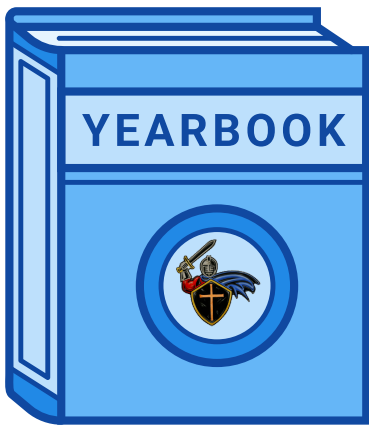
