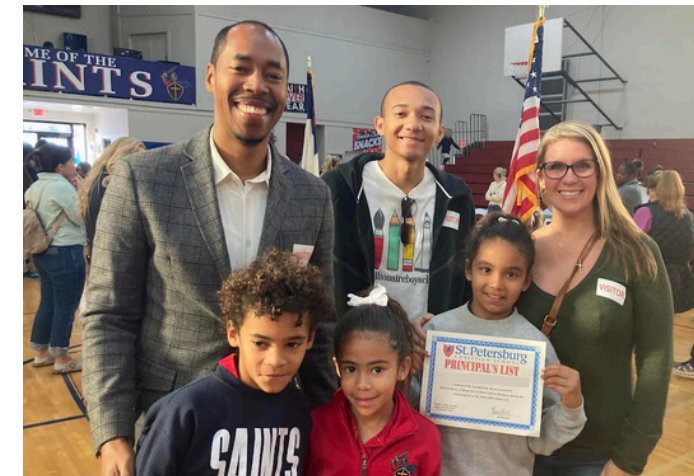

We are proud of our student's accomplishments during the 2nd Semester. Elementary students were recognized this week, not only for their academic achievements but for their Christian character and outstanding effort!



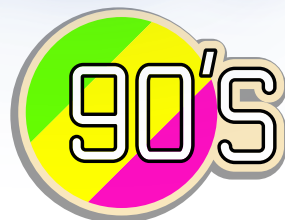
