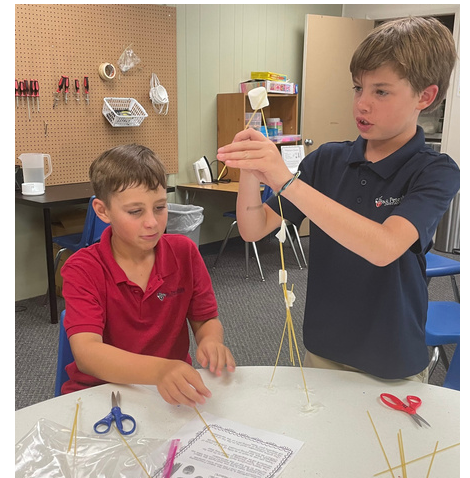
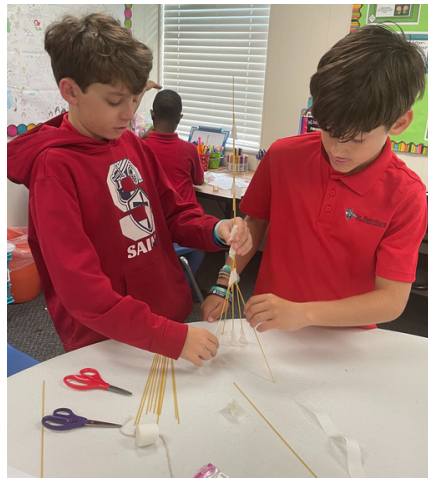
A LONG WALK FOR 7TH GRADE

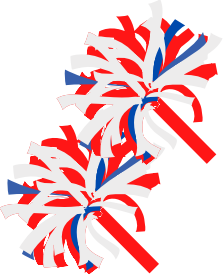
