# 5TH GRADE FINALE



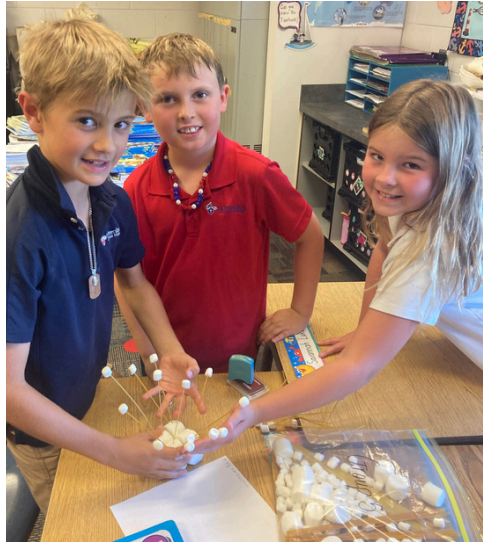
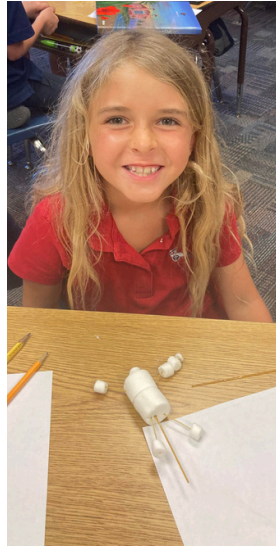

# 7TH GRADE SCIENCE

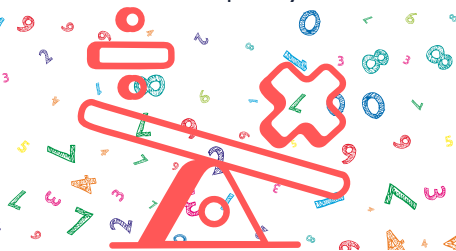

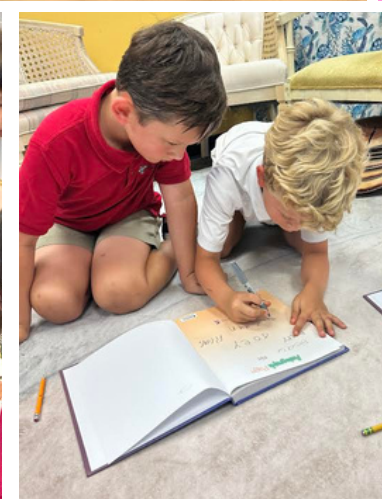
## 3RD GRADE FRAX SUCCESS

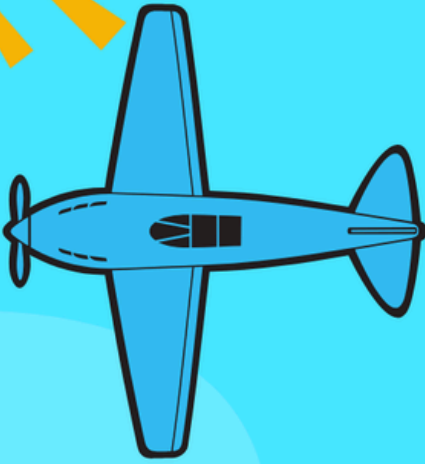

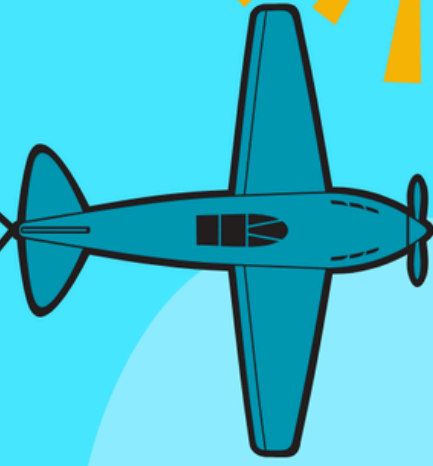
